



At a Glance

Start/Finish	Van transfers from and return to Bangkok. The ride starts in Khao Yai
Duration	8 days total, 6 days riding route
Total Distance	Approximately 1,340 km (833 miles)
Daily Distances	140 to 310 km





Day 1: Arrival in Khao Yai

At midday gather at a meeting point in Bangkok for a van transport up to the beautiful area of Khao Yai where the tour starts. Check into the hotel, meet fellow travelers for a welcome dinner and a presentation on the tour itinerary.

Day 2: Khao Yai – Khao Kho

Before hitting the road, basic group riding rules will be covered and guests will get familiar with the bikes, riding practices and with the local riding environment at our service center. Hit the road and cruise on provincial roads along rice paddies and through farm villages. At the end of the day, climb into the mountains of Khao Kho.

Day 3: Khao Kho – Chiang Khan

Wake up enjoying the breathtaking views and fresh air of Khao Kho. The ride heads further north in the mountains towards Phu Rua and the Lao border. In the afternoon reach the Mekong River at Chiang Khan, which forms the natural border between Thailand and Laos. Chiang Khan is a lovely small town with restaurants, coffee and souvenir shops and it is the final destination for the day.

Day 4: Kanchanaburi – Bangkok

Enjoy more spectacular views following the Mekong River travelling eastward towards Nong Khai, the main border crossing to Laos. Around lunchtime make a detour into the gentle mountains of Sangkhom District and then back along Mekong for a breathtaking scenic cruise into the city of Nong Khai.



Day 5: Nong Khai– Khon Kaen

Leaving the mighty Mekong behind, ride south through the landscape of Isaan towards Udon Thani. Head off the main road and cruise along provincial roads through Nong Bua Lam Phu province towards Khon Kaen and end the day enjoying this provincial city.



Day 6: Khon Kaen - Chaiyapum

Get back on the road and cruise along shimmering rice paddies and villages. Climb up to the Khuean Bon Dam and take in its spectacular views. The area offers a perfect riding environment. In the late afternoon, reach Chaiyapum and stop for the night.

Day 7: Chaiyapum – Khao Yai

Begin the return to Khao Yai, journeying through the south Isaan region, sampling its famous cuisine and enjoying the scenery of this beautiful region. After the ride, enjoy a farewell party with newfound friends.

Day 8: Departure from Khao Yai

Enjoy a healthy breakfast at the hotel and spend the morning at leisure. At midday, transfer in a van back to Bangkok. Alternatively, guests can opt to stay on in this beautiful area with its hiking, national park, vineyards, golf courses, horse riding and much more.
