Wherever you are in Barcelona, there's always something to see nearby: See the contemporary architecture and markets that are a treat for the senses. The treasures of this ancient Roman and medieval city will captivate you.

Toledo is one of the Spanish cities with the greatest wealth of monuments. Known as the "city of the three cultures", because Christians, Arabs and Jews lived together there for centuries, behind its walls

Málaga is known for its high-rise hotels and resorts jutting up from yellow-sandy beaches. Looming over the modern skyline are the city's 2 massive hilltop citadels, the Alcazaba and ruined Gibralfaro. The city's soaring Renaissance Gothic cathedral is nicknamed La Manquita "one-armed lady" because one of its towers was curiously left un-built. Wind your way down the Narrow streets for a wonderful choice of traditional and modern restaurants and bars.

Granada is known for grand examples of medieval architecture dating to the Moorish occupation, especially the Alhambra. This sprawling hilltop fortress complex encompasses royal palaces, serene patios, and reflecting pools from the Nasrid dynasty, as well as the fountains and orchards of the Generalife gardens.

Seville is famous for flamenco dancing and the Gothic Seville Cathedral, the site of Christopher Columbus's tomb and a minaret turned bell tower, the Giralda.

Cordoba is best known for La Mezquita, an immense mosque dating from 784 A.D., featuring a columned prayer hall and older Byzantine mosaics.

Mérida, was founded by the Romans in the 1st century B.C. Remains of the ancient city include the still-used Teatro Romano, which has a double tier of columns rising onstage.

Evora is one of the best tourist destinations of central Portugal, it is a delightful city that exudes Portuguese charm and boasts a vast array of fascinating historical monuments.

Lisbon is a historical city where the sun shines 290 days a year and the temperature rarely drops below 15oC. A city where you feel safe wandering around day or night. From the imposing São Jorge Castle, you will find the view encompasses the old city's pastel-colored buildings. Discover the vibrance of this charming city with it's museums and monuments.
